Further to my letter of 2<sup>nd</sup> December, I am asking if you will meet me and other affected MPs, urgently, to discuss what I understand is the imminent introduction of amended regulations for the Royal Parks (as they affect parking charges). This information was conveyed in a letter to The Friends of Bushy and Home Parks.

When I met the Head of the Royal Parks at the beginning of the process, I was given the firm impression that when final proposals emerged they would be discussed further and would be the subject of parliamentary debate and approval. This appears not now to be the case.
